1. This week's text, Zechariah 9-11, is a difficult and complicated passage to understand. Nevertheless, what stood out to you? Are there any common Old Testament themes? What does this passage say about God's character?

2. Without getting bogged down, what are some observations about the condition of our world? How does your understanding of God's plan revealed in His Word direct your outlook? How does this impact the way you live?

3. Pastor Matt said that God does not neglect and reject His people forever based on Zechariah 10:6. Have you felt unworthy or neglected by God in the past? What circumstance led to these feelings? God promised to establish a renewal for Israel and supply them with stability and strength. Through what means does God supply renewal, stability and strength to you?

4. Jesus is the Good Shepherd, who gives His life for the sheep. Read John 10:1-18. What are the character traits of a good shepherd? In what ways has Jesus demonstrated these in your life? How can you use your walk with Jesus to encourage someone in your D-group to follow the Good Shepherd?
