1.	Nehemiah 9 records a lengthy prayer that is predominately Israel's confession of sin. When was the last time you "settled accounts" with the Lord? Why is it important to keep a short account of our sins?
2.	We often want to (1) take the reins of our own lives, (2) make idols out of ungodly things, and (3) reject God's protective boundaries. How are these three attitudes/actions visible in your life?
3.	Read Psalm 106:43-46. How does God respond to His people when they sin and rebel? Why would He respond in this way, and why is His response so amazing or surprising?
4.	God's grace is defined as "God's favor toward the unworthy." When we have communion at church, we often refer to Luke 22:19-20 as a remembrance of the new covenant in His blood. What reasons might there be that make this memorial so vital? How can confession serve as a similar reminder?
