1. What are the three propositional questions given in the introduction to the sermon? How do they relate to the introduction and purpose of Luke's gospel?

2. Luke is recognized as the author of his gospel. Why is Luke's background important in understanding his writing? Discuss why authorship is important when reading the Bible.

3. The gospel of Luke can be divided into three life sections: Jesus' coming, Jesus' seeking, and Jesus' saving. It is an orderly account. What was Luke's goal in writing an orderly account? Based on verses 3-4, how does Luke's order and goal benefit his readers?

4. In the gospel of Luke, we find that Jesus invites sinners to the table. What does this mean literally and figuratively? How can you invite sinners to your table?
