	2.	Satan's first temptation in Luke 4:3-4 questions God's goodness and love. What conclusions can be made of Jesus' response to Satan (see Deuteronomy 8:3 and Matthew 6:31-33)? How has God sustained you, physically or spiritually, in times of trials and trouble?
,	3.	Satan's second temptation in Luke 4:5-8 questions God's sufficiency. List some of God's characteristics that were provided in the sermon to illustrate that God is enough. How do you find sufficiency in God? Share some scriptures that support this conclusion.
	4.	Satan's third temptation in Luke 4:9-12 questions God's protection and care. Why does God care for you (see 1 Peter 2:9 and 1 Cor 6:20)? How has God demonstrated His protection and care in your life? Share some scriptures that encourage you in this truth.

5. Through these examples, we are encouraged to trust God and go to His Word when temptations arise. How can your group/members help keep you accountable in your efforts to live a victorious Christian life?
