1. What is the wildest event you have ever witnessed, or who is the wildest person you have ever met? What characteristics made them "wild"? In your own words describe John the Baptist.

- 2. How did John 3:1-2 portray the culture in which John was preaching? How did John's contemporaries perceive his proclamation? How do their responses parallel responses to the gospel today?
- 3. List some characteristics of John's message. Why was John's message so radically different from that of the religious establishment? How is John's message different from Jesus's message? What should OUR message be?

4. Read Galatians 5:22-25. This passage teaches us to live wildly faithful in the Holy Spirit by denying our ourselves. Share how, in Christ, you now live differently from the world.

5. If you have a story of how you shared the gospel with an unbeliever last week, share it with the group. This week, think about your daily interactions and share how you plan to intentionally seek out unbelievers for gospel conversations. If you already do that regularly, share how you do so with the group in hopes that it can be emulated.
