- 1. In Jesus' day, how does the culture view lepers, paralytics, or anyone with physical infirmities? Why was it significant that Jesus approached both of these men?

- 2. Leprosy was used to illustrate sin's corruption in our lives. List ways sin corrupts our lives. How did Jesus defy the culture and embrace the infirmed? What did Jesus try to show us through His actions in Luke 5:12-16? How do we treat the sin in our lives?

- 3. Paralysis was used to illustrate sin's consequences in our lives. List some consequences of sin in our lives. How did Jesus deal with the consequences of sin in Luke 5:17-26? How do sinners require love and care?

- 4. Forgiveness creates a new life and new walk. Read 2 Corinthians 5:16-19. What are some marks of a new life and new walk? How does this impact the message we are entrusted with?

- 5. We were encouraged to be patient, kind, forgiving, and compassionate when we are interacting with unbelievers. Share how you do that in your evangelistic efforts. How can you encourage each other to continue praying, engaging, and sharing the gospel with unbelievers?
